

Visitation Opportunities at Pine Haven Community

(November 19, 2021)

Per MN Department of Health guidelines, Pine Haven Community will follow visitation guidelines to help keep families connected. Visitation policies are driven by many factors. “Level I” and “Level II” COVID status definitions are outlined below. When planning visits, please check the Pine Haven COVID-19 Hotline at 507-356-2385 to determine if the facility is at Level I or II so that you can plan accordingly for the safety of all residents and yourself.

Thank you for helping stop the spread of COVID-19.

The main door at Pine Haven Care Center (210 3rd St. NW) will remain unlocked from 7:00 am to 10:00 pm every day. For those needing admittance outside of those hours, please ring the doorbell for assistance. Evergreen Place remains a secured facility with guests needing resident or staff approved entry.

Visitors are allowed at all times for any resident. You no longer need to schedule your visits 24 hours in advance, and you can have as many visitors in a resident room or apartment at any time. Visitors are requested to confine their visits to resident rooms or apartments. Common areas will not be available for gatherings.

All visitors must still check in at the Kiosk at the front door and wear required PPE (mask and eye wear). PPE will be available at the front door at all times.

Level I Definition:

There has been recent COVID -19 exposure in the last 14 days.

Level II Definition:

There has NOT been any recent COVID-19 exposures in the last 14 days.
