Therapy specialty areas include treatment for acute and chronic pain, falls and balance, low back pain, orthopedic injuries, lymphedema management, neurological rehabilitation, workers compensation rehabilitation, post-surgical recovery and much more.

Pine Haven Rehabilitation offers a large and bright space with convenient parking and access to the department directly inside the 510 1st Ave NW, Pine Island entrance. Scheduling can be quick, with flexible hours available, including weekends and can work with most insurance carriers. The department offers two private treatment areas with a variety of equipment to enhance treatments including: Nautilus weight training equipment, SciFit bikes for endurance training, range of motion, and strengthening, free weights, balance training equipment, electrical stimulation, ultrasound and more.
